ANTLER PARK MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE

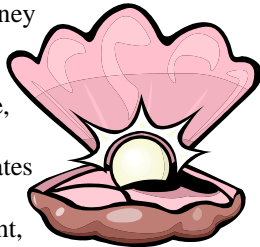
